## SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

Arrangements should be made one year in advance of the proposed marriage according to the Common Policy of the Bishops of the Province of New Jersey. Either the bride or groom must be registered with Our Lady of Sorrows Parish.

Today we encounter readings that draw us into the mystery of suffering and death. In the past few years we have witnessed the devastation of life and property through earthquakes and hurricanes. So many lifted their lament to God, simply asking, “Why?” This is an honest expression of anger toward a God who we believe is the giver of life. When we lose a loved one, we can wonder why the presence of Christ is not enough to make that person rise, even from death, as did the little girl in today’s Gospel passage. Again we raise our voices and ask, “Why?” At moments such as these, let us make the prayer of the psalmist our own: “Hear, O LORD, and have pity on me; O LORD, be my helper.” Let us pray that our mourning will one day be turned into dancing.

Father Juan Carlos attended Seton Hall University in South Orange, New Jersey, where he received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Catholic Theology, a Master of Arts degree in Systematic Theology, and a Master of Divinity degree.

Father Juan Carlos always knew he wanted to be a priest. His parents, Fausto and Nancy, have given him and his siblings the fruits of their Catholic faith. Fr. Juan Carlos has stated in the Catholic Advocate, “It is difficult for me to think of only one person in my life who God used to bring this vocation to fruition. Since I was a child, God blessed me, giving me so many people to help me in my life; they supported me in many ways in discerning my vocation toward the priesthood.” His catechists have helped him grow in faith and remain connected in the Catholic Church.
