SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

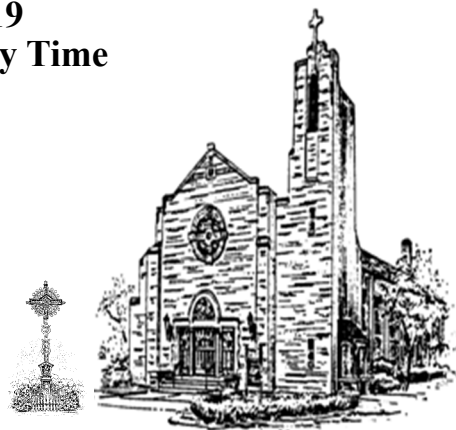

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

Arrangements should be made one year in advance of the proposed marriage according to the Common Policy of the Bishops of the Province of New Jersey. Either the bride or groom must be registered with Our Lady of Sorrows Parish.

God . . . wills everyone to be saved and to come to knowledge of the truth. — 1 Timothy 2:4

GOD IS ON THE SIDE OF THE POOR

Two of today's readings make it quite clear that God is on the side of the poor. Amos describes in detail the exploitation of the poor and needy. The psalm repeats that God acts to benefit the poor and lowly. But Luke turns things upside down, telling a tale of a conflicted steward, about to be fired, who demonstrates his cleverness and is rewarded. Like the community to whom Paul writes in Timothy, these readings are personal, directed to believers, members of the Jewish and Christian communities, who struggle to deal with personal choices about how to conduct their lives. They offer an outline for how God wishes us to live in a world as complicated and as confusing as our own.

2020 MASS INTENTION BOOK

Our 2020 Book of Mass Intentions will be opened on Monday, October 7, 2019 from 9:00 AM—4:00 PM

In order to accommodate the requests of all our PARISHIONERS, we remind you:

ONLY 6 MASSES (4 weekend & 2 weekdays) will be allowed to any One Parish Family. These Masses will be put in the Mass book in the order they are received.

- No Masses will be accepted by phone. However, you may write your list of Masses (**no more than 6**) and together with the offering send it or drop it in the mail slot at the Rectory office.
- Please include the name of the intention, the name of the person requesting the Mass, and telephone number. The name of the intention and the donor will be published in the bulletin. If you would like your Mass dates confirmed, please include a stamped self-addressed return envelope.
- If the Mass time you are requesting is not available, we will substitute a date as close as possible to the date you are requesting.

After all the parishioners have had a chance to obtain Mass intentions, you will then be able to request no more than 4 Masses at any other time (to any one Parish family).

ALL MASS STIPENDS ARE \$10.00. There will be no individual intentions for Easter, Christmas, Mothers' Day or Fathers' Day, and the week of All Souls' Day. Spiritual Bouquet Mass cards will be made available for all parishioners for these occasions.
