SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

Arrangements should be made one year in advance of the proposed marriage according to the Common Policy of the Bishops of the Province of New Jersey. Either the bride or groom must be registered with Our Lady of Sorrows Parish.

A LITTLE FAITH

Today our readings are about faith, frustration, and how much is enough. Habakkuk is a complainer having an argument with God. Timothy is encouraging a community challenged by cowardice and the apostles want more faith than they have. Things aren't happening fast enough for any of them or for us. All of them and we want God to do something sooner rather than later and we want God to give us a reason to believe that it will all work out. What does God do? God puts it back on them—and us—telling Habakkuk to describe the world he wants; telling the apostles to do more than the expected. Doing more with less is a familiar phrase today and a reminder that a little faith may be enough even for the most difficult times.

Monday, October 7, 2019 from
9:00 AM—4:00 PM

In order to accommodate the requests of all our PARISHIONERS, we remind you:

ONLY 6 MASSES (4 weekend & 2 weekdays) will be allowed to any One Parish Family. These Masses will be put in the Mass book in the order they are received.

- No Masses will be accepted by phone. However, you may write your list of Masses (**no more than 6**) and together with the offering send it or drop it in the mail slot at the Rectory office.
- Please include the name of the intention, the name of the person requesting the Mass, and telephone

number. The name of the intention and the donor will be published in the bulletin. If you would like your Mass dates confirmed, please include a stamped self-addressed return envelope.

- If the Mass time you are requesting is not available, we will substitute a date as close as possible to the date you are requesting.

After all the parishioners have had a chance to obtain Mass intentions, you will then be able to request no more than 4 Masses at any other time (to any one Parish family).

ALL MASS STIPENDS ARE \$10.00. There will be no individual intentions for Easter, Christmas, Mother's Day or Father's Day, and the week of All Souls Day. Spiritual Bouquet Mass cards will be made available for all parishioners for these occasions.

ALL SOULS DAY CANDLES



Light a candle for **All Souls Day** to remember a deceased family member or friend. Each white candle will contain a label with the name of the deceased person for whom it is being offered. Candles will be lit for All Souls Day, Saturday, November 2, 2019, and will burn for one week on the side altar.
